

User Choice Program – Cert II in Retail Makeup & Skincare SIB20110

The User Choice Program provides public funding for the delivery of the **Qualification SIB20110 - Certificate II in Retail Makeup & Skincare** to apprentices and trainees, **specifically school – based apprentices and trainees**.

Demi International Beauty Academy – (RTO) 32542 www.demiinternational.com.au has been selected as a Pre – qualified Supplier for the delivery of the Qualification SIB20110 -Certificate II in Retail Makeup & Skincare to apprentices & trainees under the User Choice Program. Therefore if you are in year 10,11 or 12 and complete your qualification while at school the Government will pay 86% of the Cert II in Retail Makeup and Skincare. You will be a qualified Makeup Artist able to work on Makeup Counters such as Napoleon, MAC, Bobby Brown, Myer, David Jones or as a Freelance Makeup Artist, while still at school.

It also sets up a great pathway for you to move into a Diploma of Beauty Therapy SIB50110 after you finish school as you would have completed more than 20% of your Diploma already, by the time you get started! **Call Demi International Beauty Academy on 07 – 5309 6635 to find out more!**

School Based Apprentices & Trainees (SATS)

School based apprentices and trainees undertake an apprenticeship or traineeship as part of their high school studies. A school based apprentice and trainee's employment and / or training arrangements must impact on their school timetable for the program to be considered 'school – based'.

School based apprentices and trainees are exempt from paying 86% of student fees under the User Choice program whilst they are at school. **The government will pay 86%** of your tuition fees to complete the Qualification SIB20110 - Certificate II in Retail Makeup & Skincare with Demi International Beauty Academy www.demiinternational.com.au and there is a small out of pocket expense of \$372.

Funding

Apprentices and trainees can only receive one government contribution for a User Choice funded qualification at any single point in time i.e. a student is not funded to undertake two school – based traineeships at the same time. However, apprentices and trainees, including school based apprentices and trainees, can only receive a maximum of two government funding contributions under the current User Choice program.

A second qualification will only be funded if it has a higher priority ranking than the first qualification that has been completed.

Australian Apprenticeship Centres (AACs) are able to provide further advice on other relevant funding rules which could apply to you.

Implication for School – Based Apprentices and Trainees

Under the User Choice arrangements, students, schools, parents and employers need to carefully consider any potential impacts a SAT may have on a student's future entitlement to another funded apprenticeship or traineeship.

As only one more apprenticeship or traineeship qualification (in a Priority One qualification or a higher priority than the first qualification) will be funded by the Government, schools are encouraged to discuss this issue with their students and parents and incorporate this consideration into the student's Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan.

It is important to remember that there are only "two bites of the cherry" in relation to government funded apprenticeships and traineeships.
