Certificate III in Beauty Services (SHB30115)

Qualification Outcomes

After completion of the Certificate III in Beauty Services, students are equipped with the basic beauty treatment skills necessary to work in a beauty salon or department store in a variety of beauty practices. The course includes pre clinical skills, client service skills and retail selling techniques. It will teach students how to provide lash and brow techniques and waxing, but does not include facials, body treatments or massage techniques.

Course Duration and Study Options

Course Duration: 4 months

Delivery: 1 x 12 week term - 12 days face to face.

Teacher Directed Study: Online 10-15 hours/week over 1 x 12 week term.

You can enrol whenever you like. As soon as you enrol you will be issued with your online access to your full set of workbooks and material to make a start. The theory component of the course can be done by correspondence online but you will be required for twelve (12) face to face intensive days to complete your practical component.

Tuition Fees

The tuition fees of \$5,300 include all teacher directed learning, learning materials, resources, stock, consumables and products for the entire Qualification.

All students will be required to pay a (non-refundable) deposit of \$500 at enrolment to secure a place in the course and cover access to an online Teacher Directed Learning Management System (LMS), your brush roll and your learning resources. **You will also receive a professional brush kit valued at \$150.**

Career Opportunities

Students successfully completing this course may go on to further their studies by completing the Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy or the Diploma of Beauty Therapy.

Assessment

The assessment methods used in the Certificate III are competency based and include written and practical tasks. The assessment tasks are completed throughout your course of study.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy Advice

The National Reading Reporting System informs the identification and description of underpinning English language, literacy and numeracy features and requirements within competency standards. The learner's language, literacy and numeracy levels are expected to be equivalent to 3/4 of the National Reporting System.

A sound level of English language skills (reading and writing skills) is required.

Oral communication - a learner will be able to use and respond to spoken language within a variety of contexts.

Numeracy and mathematics - a learner will be able to recognise and use a variety of conventions and symbolism of formal mathematics.

Support Services

Demi International will provide learners with every opportunity to complete their chosen qualification. Support from your trainer is available to ensure you understand the learning and assessment requirements once you have commenced study with Demi International Beauty Academy. The Academy will identify and access appropriate support services, and ensure the necessary services are provided for participants as required.

APPRENTICESHIP/TRAINEESHIP OPPORTUNITIES

This qualification is suitable for Full Time and Part Time Apprenticeships and Trainees. WHO CAN APPLY?

Apprenticeships and traineeships are available to individuals from the age of 15. School students, school leavers and job seekers are eligible to apply. There are no general prerequisites.
