Diploma of Remedial Massage (HLT52015)

The Diploma of Remedial Massage qualification provides the skills required for competence in remedial massage practice. Practitioners at this level may be self-employed as independent practitioners or may work within a larger health service. The diploma is the minimal level for receiving WorkCover and Private Insurance Provider numbers.

Qualification Outcomes

The course covers the provision of remedial massage treatment to clients with specific needs such as injury management, rehabilitation, palliative care and aged care. Classes for this course are a mix of theory and practical subjects, and include practical work in a clinic environment. Practitioners at this level may supervise other massage therapists. The diploma is the minimal level for receiving WorkCover and Private Insurance Provider numbers. A career in Remedial Massage is varied and exciting. We provide our students with a set of oils, some massage balms and Massage Reference Manuals and Texts.

Course Duration and Study Options

Course Duration: 12 Months

Delivery: 4 x 10 week terms - 1.5 day (12 hours) a week face to face.

Teacher Directed Study: Online 15-20 hours/week over 4 x 10 week term.

Clinic Hours: 200 Supervised hours over 12 months.

Amount of Training: 1280 hours in total to meet Massage Association Standards.

Tuition Fees

The course tuition costs are \$12,800 of which up to \$10,342 can be covered by VET Student Loans. The balance of \$2,458 can be covered on payment plan of \$50.26 per week inc direct debit fees. The tuition fees include all teacher directed learning, learning materials, resources, oils and balms, towels, access to industry experts and field trips.

Students will be provided with all 3 Textbooks: Trail Guide to the Body, 5th Ed. Andrew Biel, The Textbook of Remedial Massage, Sandra Grace & Mark Deal & Theory & Practice of Therapeutic Massage, Mark F. Beck.

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Additional Fees not included in Tuition Fees

The assessment methods used in the Diploma are competency based and include written and practical tasks. The assessment tasks are completed throughout your course of study.

Government Study Assist - VET Student Loans

Demi International Beauty Academy is a registered training organisation and has been approved to offer VET Student loans to eligible students under the Higher Education Support Act 2003. The Diploma of Remedial Massage is an approved course. VET Student Loans can be used to pay part of an eligible student's tuition fees. Students who access Vet Student Loans are charged 20% loading from the Federal Government. The total debt to be incurred at completion of this Qualification will be \$12,410.40.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy Advice

The National Reading Reporting System informs the identification and description of underpinning English language, literacy and numeracy features and requirements within competency standards. The learner's language, literacy and numeracy levels are expected to be equivalent to 3/4 of the National Reporting System. A sound level of English language skills (reading and writing skills) is required. Oral communication - a learner will be able to use and respond to spoken language within a variety of contexts. Numeracy and mathematics - a learner will be able to recognise and use a variety of conventions and symbolism of formal mathematics.

Support from your trainer is available to ensure you understand the learning and assessment requirements once you have commenced study with Demi International Beauty Academy. The Academy will identify and access appropriate support services, and ensure the necessary services are provided for participants as required.

RTO ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students should have completed a Senior Secondary Certificate of Education for the completion of Year 12 **or both:** The student is to be assessed as competent at or above Exit Level 3 in an Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF) Literacy and Numeracy Exam **and also** The student must display the required level of competence Demi International reasonably believes is required for a Diploma level of Study. Younger applicants are welcome to apply, and entry will be at the discretion of the RTO.
